# Academic Team



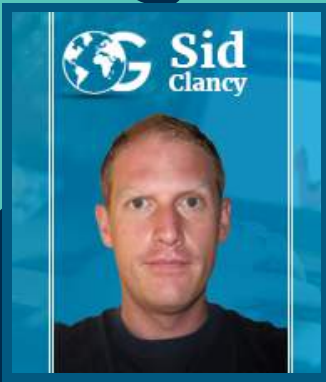

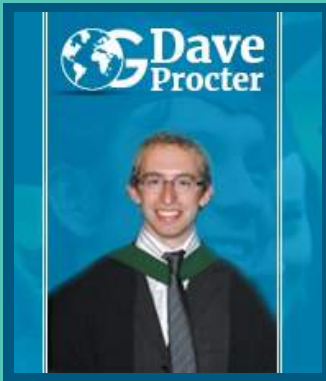

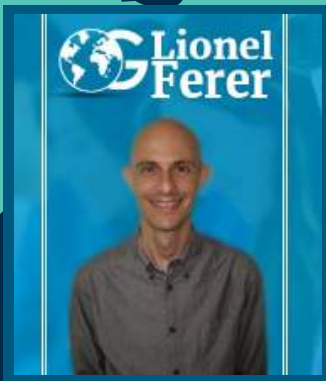
